Million dollar Lilyfield home for just \$15

A million dollar Lilyfield home with city views and all the “mod cons” is the latest prize home announced by BoysTown today.

The prize home package, valued at over \$1.2 million, will be won for as little as \$15, according to the Charitable Art Union’s General Manager, Fundraising, Mr Keith Coventry.

“BoysTown prize homes are known for their quality finishes, features and amazing locations. This home definitely lives up to those standards,” Keith said.

Spread over two levels, this three-bedroom home has been superbly renovated to the highest standard. It features light-filled living areas which open onto a deck and fully landscaped gardens.

Upstairs, the master suite features French doors, opening onto views of the city skyline. An ensuite and built-in wardrobe also form part of the master suite.

The home is situated in a quiet cul-de-sac in a highly sought-after residential area, minutes from the Sydney CBD. Rozelle Village, with its local shops and gourmet restaurants, is just 2 kilometers away. The home is also minutes from Balmain and the University of Sydney.

The prize, valued at \$1,200,260, also includes over \$64,000 in furniture and electrical and \$110,000 in gold bullion.

The winner will also have the option of choosing a luxury home at Buderim on Queensland’s Sunshine Coast.
