Record support for prize home drawn tomorrow

Records are tumbling around BoysTown's Christmas prize home with record crowds expected at tomorrow's draw for the charitable art union's most popular lottery with the biggest ever prize value.

The 2008 Christmas Prize Home has surpassed even its many stunning predecessors to achieve record ticket sales according to BoysTown General Manager, Keith Coventry.

"Our Christmas Prize Home is the premier prize we offer each year but this time we've taken luxury living to the next level by offering our lottery ticket buyers what is a truly outstanding beachfront property," Mr Coventry explains.

"We have raised the stakes in prize home standards with both the total value of the \$1.88 million dollar prize package and the uncompromised luxury of the exclusive ground floor beachfront residence.

"The chance to begin the New Year living in one of Australia's most beautiful areas, mortgage-free, has clearly appealed to our generous supporters and they have helped us raise the largest amount of money ever for a single lottery in our 48 year history," he said.

The \$1.88 million prize package also includes Furniture and Electrical valued at \$90,740, Gold Bullion valued at \$10,000 and \$5,000 Qantas Travel.
